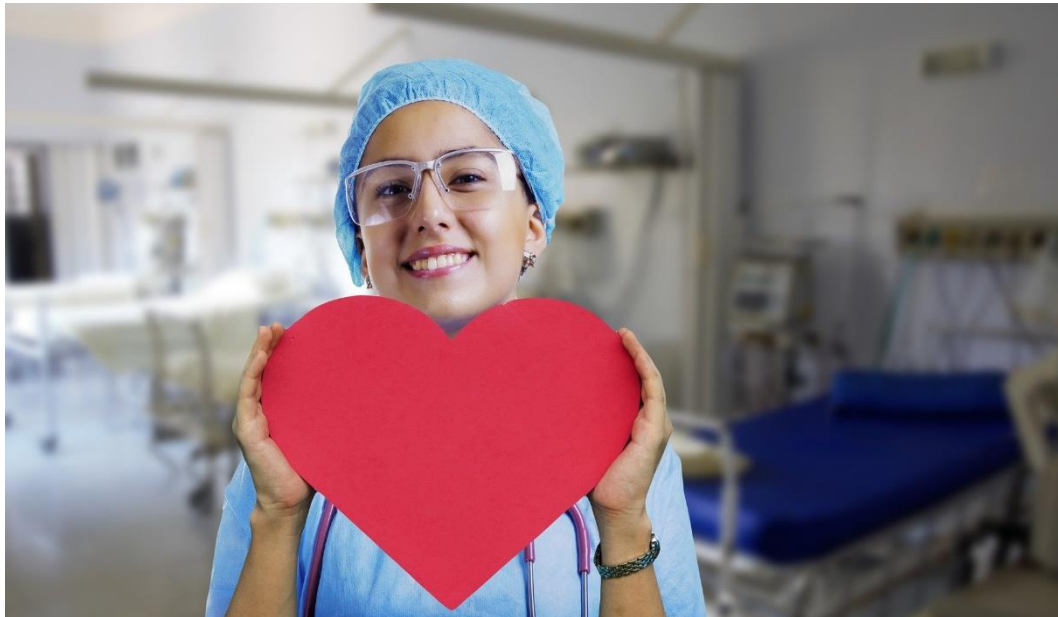
Mitsubishi Electric donates € 100,000 to Papa Giovanni XXIII hospital in Bergamo and San Gerardo hospital in Monza
