MITSUBISHI ELECTRIC VOLUNTEERS GO DOWN TO THE TRACK TO SUPPORT SPECIAL OLYMPICS XXVIII ITALIAN NATIONAL WINTER GAMES

Mitsubishi Electric continues its commitment to Special Olympics by providing valuable support to more than 485 athletes competing in Bormio.

Agrate Brianza (MB), 10th February 2017 - Mitsubishi Electric's Italian Branch has supported events organized by Special Olympics Italia' for many years, not only as a sponsor but also as a true supporter of the organization. The company continued its support at the 28th edition of the Special Olympics National Winter Games, which was held in Bormio from 5th to 10th February. More than 100 technicians, 300 volunteers and about 170 family members supported 485 athletes with and without intellectual disabilities from 15 regions across Italy, and from Mendrisio, Switzerland to compete in this unique sporting event. The partnership is part of a large Social Responsibility program by Mitsubishi Electric's Italian Branch, which promotes the values of sport as an opportunity for inclusion, solidarity and integration.

Athletes from 48 Special Olympics delegations from all over Italy competed in several different sporting events from downhill to cross-country skiing, races with competitors wearing snowshoes, and snowboarding. In addition, the recreational sports initiative "Try Sport" encouraged participants to engage in activities like floorball and ice skating, allowing the athletes to try out new disciplines.

The Special Olympics Athlete oath "Let me win.
