## Mitsubishi Electric gets high school students closer to robotics

The initiative "Open doors to school" allowed to meet more than two hundred students of five local technical high schools

Agrate Brianza, June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 - Mitsubishi Electric Italian Branch announces the results of the first edition of the initiative "Open doors to school" involving five local technical high schools – Istituto Hesemberger (Monza), ITIS Volta (Lodi), ITIS Giorgi (Milan), ITIS Leonardo da Vinci (Carate Brianza), ITIS Einstein (Vimercate) involving more than 200 students. This important result allowed the Japanese company to bring the world of high technical education closer to the business world, focusing on the field of industrial automation and robotics.

The initiative has come after the opening of the new Factory Automation & CNC Training & Demo Room at the Mitsubishi Electric headquarters in Agrate Brianza in June 2016. Due to the key role played by trainings within the company strategy, Factory Automation Division started a program alongside the technical schools in the neighboring provinces, organizing structured courses and visits to the company for a theoretical and practical training about robotics.

All students involved attended a two-day course with a program which included both a training session about the basics of robotics and a visit to the Factory Automation & CNC Training & Demo Room with demonstration of various practical applications. Moreover, the initiative continued at the site of high schools involved, where Mitsubishi Electric technicians installed a robot which enabled the students to deepen their knowledge regarding the programming and applications, following the indications of the company trainer.

This experience was considered very interesting by all the attendants and useful for students' educational and vocational guidance as well as for technological upgrading of teachers involved.

Training has always been playing a key role in which the whole Mitsubishi Electric Group firmly believes, the best way to acquire practical-theoretical knowledge and develop those skills which enable future technicians to successfully establish themselves in the world of work.

The activities of the program "Open doors to school" will start again at the beginning of the school year 2017/2018 in order to continue the stay alongside the new generations and provide them with qualified support in the process of getting themselves ready to enter into a company.
